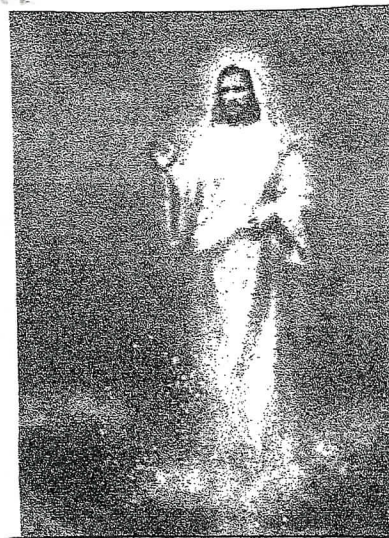
“Who can this be? Even the wind and the sea obey him.”

to be with him.

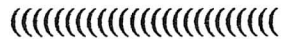
So it is with sadness we will soon say fare-
