**Catholic Home Missions: Next Weekend.**

Next Sunday, our parish will be taking up a collection for the Catholic Home Missions Appeal. This Appeal supports missions here in the United States. The Archdiocese of Anchorage has 11,500 registered Catholic families, 140,000 square miles, and only 30 active diocesan priests. Sadly, such shortages occur often in United States missions dioceses. The Catholic Home Missions Appeal supports religious education and seminary training to bring increased pastoral care to our home mission parishes. Please give generously in next week’s Appeal. A portion of the collection will also support the effort by the Church for Black and Native American Indians.

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**Five Steps to Safer Environments:** The diocese of Sacramento mandates that all adults who work with children and youth in our parishes and schools must undergo a background check and complete child abuse prevention training through [www.shieldthevulnerable.com](http://www.shieldthevulnerable.com). There are five key steps all adults can take to help prevent child abuse.

- 1. Know the warning signs of child abuse.
- 2. Control access to children by carefully selecting the adults who work with children and youth.
- 3. Monitor all programs for the safety of children and youth.
- 4. Be aware of the sensitive to what is going on in the lives of children.
- 5. Communicate concerns to the appropriate person in authority.
