Upcoming Changes to Our Diocesan newspapers: Bishop Soto recently announced that, because of the recent difficult economic times, our diocese is no longer able to sustain the high cost involved in the publication of the Catholic Herald and El Heraldo. The diocese has found a Catholic publishing service which will produce a bi-monthly diocesan magazine at a substantial saving. In addition to the monetary savings, this new magazine will focus more on diocesan news, be available electronically, and will reach a wider audience. Bishop Soto added that they are also exploring alternative communication mediums in Spanish. The last edition will be in June and the new Catholic Herald magazine will be the Sept/Oct. issue which will come out in late August.

April Child Abuse Prevention Month: Teach Kids to Protect Themselves at Home.

We consider our homes to be safe places for our children. But being home alone can pose risks for children. Here are a few tips to teach kids that will help keep them safe when you are not with them at home:
Never answer the door.

Do not invite anyone in the house without the permission of a parent or guardian.

Don't tell anyone on the phone that your parents are not at home. Instead tell them that your parent cannot come to the phone and take a message.
