Furnace "Red-tagged" at Christ the King Church. It was discovered on Dec.6 that the propane tank was empty at Christ the King Church. After refilling half of it, they could not relight the pilot lights on the heating units. Almanor Energy sent an inspector on Dec.7 and determined that there is significant rust and other clear signs of gas leakage. There fore, they re-tagged the furnace, which means they cannot be relighted or used. Two new heaters will need to replace and installed, should we choose to do so. An estimate of \$8.800 was received. The finance council met on Tuesday and discussed this, and many other issues. In the mean time, religious education classes for children will move to the Wilkinson's home. Special thanks to Ken and Faye for their hospitality. I will keep you up-to-date as we determine a solution. Fr. Larry.
