**2009 Annual Catholic Appeal Update:** As of June 1, the Diocesan Office of Stewardship and Development has received 19,964 gifts and pledges totaling \$2,266,466 from the 2009 Annual Catholic Appeal. This represents a 22% increase in participation and a 17% increase in dollars over the 2008 Appeal. Here at Our Lady of the Snows Parish, we received 40 gifts and \$4,634 in commitments. Our parish will receive 25% of all commitments to be used for our own social service needs. Thank you for your continued generosity in helping our church serve those most in need in our local communities.
