Schedule Update for August 22 and 29

As Fr. Larry announced last Sunday, we are awaiting a final decision from the contractor on the completion date of our new church. This will be published in next week's bulletin. In the mean time, we have two scenarios for the Mass schedules for Sunday, August 22 and August 29.

If we receive confirmation that the church will be completed before August 29, then the schedule will be:

Saturday, Aug. 21: 5:00p.m. Special Mass and Social marking the closure of Our Lady of the Snows Church, Westwood.

Sunday, Aug. 22: 8:00a.m. Mass at Christ the King Church, Chester, followed by a 9:30a.m. Special Mass and Social marking the closure of the church.

Sunday, August 29: 9:30a.m. Mass of Dedication with Bishop Soto at Our Lady of the Snows Church, Lake Almanor, followed by a parish picnic on the grounds.

Please note that on the dedication weekend we are not permitted to celebrate other Masses. Therefore, there will not be a 5:00p.m. Vigil Mass or 8:00a.m. Sunday Mass.

If we receive confirmation that the church will not be completed before August 29, then the schedule will be:

Saturday, Aug. 21: Confessions 3:30 to 4:30 p.m. at Our Lady of the Snows Church, Westwood followed by the Vigil Mass at 5:00 p.m.

Sunday, Aug. 22: 8:00 a.m. and 9:30 a.m. Masses at Christ the King Church, Chester.

Saturday, Aug. 28* and Sunday, Aug.29: Same schedule as Aug. 21 and 22.

The rectory recorder will have the latest update on the schedule. Call 256-3344 for more information or Fr. Larry at 283-0890.

Annual Mission

Appeal, Aug.15th.

Once a year parishes of the Diocese of Sacramento welcome a representative from the foreign missions to speak at their Masses. This year, on the weekend of Aug.14-15, we welcome Fr. Anthony Gnanapragasam who will speak on behalf of the people of the Dioceses of Mannar, Sri Lanka. The island nation off the south coast of India has been devastated by a brutal civil war for 25 years and, most recently, by the tsunami, one of the worst natural disasters in recent memory.
