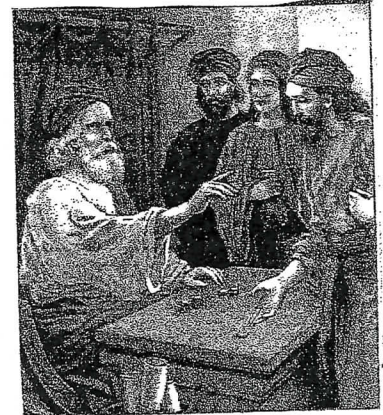

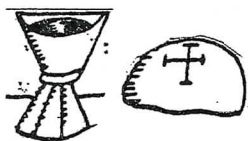
Chester Sunday Mass at 9:30am Chester Confessions after Mass on first Sunday of the month.

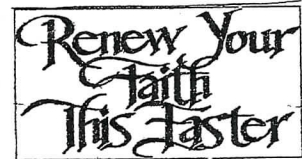

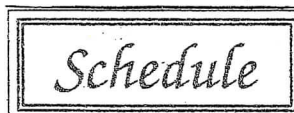
