Healing After Abortion Retreat February 19-21. Struggling after an abortion? Still seeking peace years after the choice? Come to a Rachel's Vineyard Retreat, February 19-21 in Auburn, sponsored by the Diocese of Sacramento. The weekend retreat is a unique and effective process designed specifically to help you experience the mercy and compassion of God. There are many exercises to help you grieve your loss and an opportunity to understand and release the deep feelings of anger, shame, guilt and grief that frequently accompany an abortion experience.
