**Note to All Eucharistic Ministers Serving at Mass:** In 2002, a new edition of the Roman Missal (the book used by the priest during Mass) was issued. There were a few changes to rubrics at that time; however, it has come to my attention that one of them has not been implemented at our parish. Currently extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion come forward to the sanctuary following the sign of peace and during the singing of the Lamb of God. The universal and diocesan norm is now that ministers should not approach the altar until after the priest has received communion. So beginning the first Sunday in August, I am requesting all Eucharistic Ministers to come forward from the pews as the priest is receiving from the chalice. Please remind one another of this new practice. Thank you and may God bless you for serving our parish through your important ministry. -- Fr. Larry
