Results Released of the 2010 annual Catholic Appeal

As you may recall every winter all parishes of the diocese conduct the Annual Catholic Appeal, which raises much – need funds to assist vital human service programs throughout the diocese, as well as provide funds for the needs of our own parish and community. Twenty – five percent is returned to our own parish. This year throughout the diocese 21,230 people gave a one-time gift or pledge, a one-percent decline from last year. However, the funds raised reflected an eight-percent increase totaling \$2,695,215.

This year our parish's participation decreased by 11 percent resulting in \$3,224 raised, a 25-percent decrease from last year. This is understandable given the difficult financial times and that we are in the midst of conducting a capital campaign to fund our new church and social hall. May God bless you for your kindness and, through the hundreds of programs assisted, for doing the works of our Lord Jesus. --- Fr. Larry.

Child Abuse Prevention Month Where Do Your Kids Spend Their Time?

You can help keep your children safe by knowing where they spend their time. Get to know adults who show up at various locations in the community where your children gather for sports or recreation. Be wary of adults who seem more interested in creating relationship with children than with other adults. Pay attention when an adult seems to single out a particular child for a relationship or special attention. Special favors offered to only one child may be a warning sign of something inappropriate.
