Upcoming Changes to Our Diocesan newspapers: Bishop Soto recently announced that, because of the recent difficult economic times, our diocese is no longer able to sustain the high cost involved in the publication of the Catholic Herald and El Herald. The diocese has found a Catholic publishing service which will produce a bi-monthly diocesan magazine at a substantial saving. In addition to the monetary savings, this new magazine will focus more on diocesan news, be available electronically, and will reach a wider audience. Bishop Soto added that they are also exploring alternative communication mediums in Spanish. The last edition will be in June and the new Catholic Herald magazine will be the Sept/Oct. issue which will come out in late August.
