Once a year parishes of the Diocese of Sacramento welcome a representative from the foreign missions to speak at their Masses. This year, on the weekend of Aug.14-15, we welcome Fr. Anthony Gnanapragasam who will speak on behalf of the people of the Dioceses of Mannar, Sri Lanka. The island nation off the south coast of India has been devastated by a brutal civil war for 25 years and, most recently, by the tsunami, one of the worst natural disasters in recent memory.

The Catholic Church is deeply involved in humanitarian work among the suffering people, where the majority of the people are Buddhists and Hindus. This way of witnessing brings Christ's love and compassion to those in need. Please keep the people of Sri Lanka and all foreign missions in your prayers.
