#### **Child Abuse Prevention Month – The Road to Priesthood Involves a Rigorous Formation Process.**

Seminary formation involves much more than academic study. Prior to Ordination, a candidate for priesthood goes through a lengthy evaluation, including psychological analysis, appropriate boundaries training, and an internship during which time he lives in a rectory and works with priests, staff and parishioners. No one is ordained unless faculty, staff and advisors conclude that the candidate has attained an emotional, psychological and sexual maturity appropriate for his age and for the celibate life of a priest.
