Prevalence of Child Sexual Abuse
Child sexual abuse is a great deal more prevalent than many imagine. In fact, studies tell us that one in ten adult men and one in five adult women say that they were molested before the age of 18. That means that, directly or indirectly, a child sexual abuse will touch most of us during our lifetime. And although we would like to believe that most accusations are false, the facts, tell us that children rarely lie about being-molested. In fact, they rarely tell anyone at all. An adult study about the prevalence of sexual abuse found that 42% of the men and women who are victimized as children had never told anyone.
