## **Building Progress Report from Fr. Larry.**

As I explained last Sunday at Mass, this week was vital in determining our ability to meet our dedication date of October 10. The most critical issues needed to be addressed and resolved. The good news is that we surmounted many of the major obstacles. These included Wednesday's successful inspection of the steel frame connections by the county building department, which allow us to proceed with completion of the roofing, the installation of the fire suppression system, and notification from PG&E that we are on their schedule to begin the installation of the electrical hookups this week. While there are many other hurdles we need to face in the weeks to come. I believe this is very encouraging news.

Thank you for your payers and concerns. Please keep on praying! As mentioned, I will be away for two weeks on vacation.
