Church Dedication Postponed Until December 5th. Fr. Larry will speak at the Masses this weekend to give us a status report of the construction of our new church at Lake Almanor. While the architect and contractor believe there is good chance we can still complete construction by October 10, it provides no room for any delays with either the county inspectors or the subcontractors. Given that we must also coordinate this date with the closing our churches in Westwood and Chester, this results in a situation that involves too much pressure and risk. Although we are all aware of the drawback of waiting until December, it is Fr. Larry's best judgment that it is the right decision for all of the many parishioners involved. Please continue to keep our new spiritual home in your prayers and let us look forward to a wonderful celebration on December 5th.
